ABSTRACT: Victoria Glaser is a music educator, arranger, and composer born in Amherst, MA. She was the Glee Club Director and taught music theory at the Dana Hall School from 1945-1959.

BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH:

Victoria Merrylees Glaser (VMG) (1918-2008) was the Director of the Glee Club and taught music theory at the Dana Hall School from 1945-1959. She was born on September 11, 1918 in Amherst, MA. She is the daughter of Otto Charles and Dorothy Gibbs Merrylees Glaser. VMG graduated from Radcliffe College with an A.B. in 1940 and an A.M. in 1943.

VMG is a teacher, music director, arranger, and composer. She taught at Wellesley College from 1943-1946, Dana Hall from 1945-1959, the New England Conservatory Music Extension division in Boston from 1957-1982, and the Longy School of Music in Cambridge from 1972-1993. VMG was known in the Boston musical community for her instrumental compositions and is mentioned by Howard Pollack in his book *Harvard Composers: Walter Piston and His Students, from Elliott Carter to Frederic Rzewski*. E.C. Schirmer and G.Schirmer published her choral arrangements and original compositions. In 1971, she wrote *Training for Musicianship*.

VMG died on April 14, 2008 in Cambridge, MA.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE:

The Victoria Glaser Collection (DH2007-019) is arranged into four series:

Series I consists of programs from concerts performed by the Dana Hall Glee Club from 1951-1966. Some programs are from performances solely given by the Dana Hall Glee Club and others are from performances with other independent schools and include the New England Preparatory School Music Festival Chorus. There is a list of the Dana Hall Music Collection, a non-dated newspaper clipping, music for four choral compositions, and Dana Hall commencement programs from 1951-1960.

Series II contains 37 sound discs, 33 1/3 and 78 rpm, from 1945-1963 including the Dana Hall Glee Club and the New England Preparatory School Festival Chorus. 11 of the sound discs came from Patrick Maxfield, Head of Technical Services at the New England Conservatory of Music Library.

Series III includes a partial manuscript of *Music as Aural Body-Language: A Study in the Psychology of Musical Expressions*.

Series IV contains miscellaneous notes from her classes for the New England Conservatory of Music.

The materials were received in no order.
